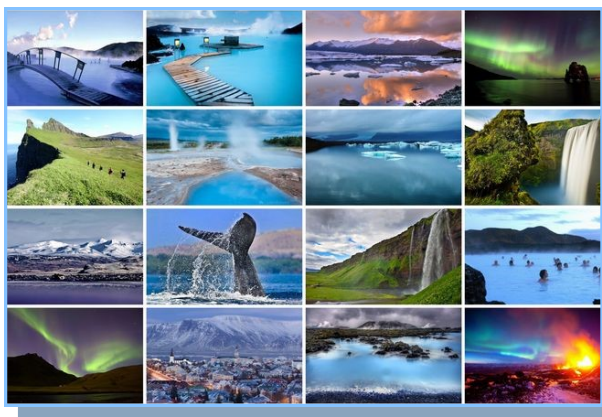

THE PROGRAM OF THE VIRTUAL LTT ACTIVITY

19th April, 2021 - Monday

- ◆ 9:00 - 9:20 Opening remarks
- ◆ 9:20-9:30 Musical performance by students
- ◆ 9:30 - 11:00 **Official welcoming** - Presentation of the school (virtual tour of the school) and students' introduction

20th April, 2021 - Tuesday

- ◆ 9:00 - 10:00 **Fact-finding virtual visit of the city** and a Kahoot game about the information students gained from the fact finding visit



- ◆ 10:00 - 10:30 **Official welcoming by the Prime Minister**

- ◆ 10:30 - 11:00 Welcoming in different languages by students and staff members of Rimaskóli and **video premier of an Icelandic song** prepared by the Icelandic team for all the partners. (Icelandic team previously sends the video to the partners so that all can learn and practice the song, record them singing and upload the videos on TwinSpace.)



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21st April, 2021 - Wednesday

- ◆ 9:00 - 10:00 - **Virtual fact-finding visit of the country** (UNESCO heritage in Iceland) and a Kahoot game. The fact-finding trip around Iceland will be 'guided' by our project mascots John and Mary.



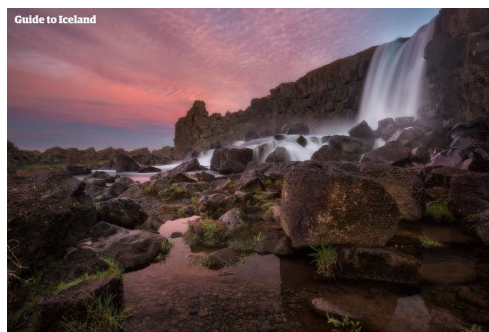
- ◆ 10:00 - 11:00 Students from Iceland talk about their experience of a new eruption in Iceland. **Workshop** - crafts, volcano eruptions. The Icelandic team previously sends teaching video with instructions and necessary ingredients to the partners. During the workshop, each partner team makes their own volcano and takes video and photos which will be uploaded on TwinSpace.



- ◆ 16:00 - 17:00 **Teachers' meeting**, writing the certificates of attendance, the minutes of the meeting, planning the last virtual meeting in Romania.

22nd April, 2021 - Thursday

- ◆ **Virtual fact-finding visits** of museums, parks and UNESCO and national reservations in Iceland, like: Þingvellir National Park (UNESCO heritage), Vatnajökull National Park, Skógafoss waterfall and Reynisfjara beach in South Iceland, Svartifoss, Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss, Reykjavik Maritime Museum, The Saga Museum, The National Museum of Iceland, etc. (Q&A session)
- ◆ **Workshop:** Working in groups all the participants prepare some presentations (1/group) about UNESCO and national heritage in Iceland, using the information they gathered during this online LTT activity, upload them on TwinSpace and present them during the workshop on Friday.



23rd April, 2021 - Friday

- ◆ 9:00 - 10:00 - **Presentations** from the workshop that took place on Thursday.
- ◆ **Meeting a traditional Icelandic family**, traditional food and beverage (Q&A session)
- ◆ 10:00 - 11:00 **Feedback** using Menti, play a game made by Genially and the **Closing ceremony**



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
